Beyond surfing and sea turtles, wildlife watching, and hammock training, the name Camaronal refers to a shrimp hatchery a few hundred meters from the coastline. All these nearby shrimp translates into some of the best inshore and surf-fishing in all of Costa Rica.


The region is sparsely populated; the Ora River was bridged just four years ago, and Guanacaste hustle and bustle has yet to make it across. The rural feel is boosted by the Camaronal Wildlife Refuge that comprises the Maritime Zone of the region. Dedicated primarily to the protection of sea turtles that nest on this beach in large numbers, it offers public parking and security and ensures that Camaronal will never be plagued by the beach development styles of Tamarindo and Flamingo to the northwest, Santa Teresa to southeast.






Man cannot live on surf alone, however, and Lomas de Cocobolo is 4 kilometers from basic supplies and just 12 km from the bustling tourism destination of Samara and its laundry list of guided activities, haute cuisine, hotels, rental car agencies, and other conveniences. Yet for all of that, Camaronal itself remains rural and lightly populated, still remote next to the congestion and crowds of more recognizable Gold Coast place names like Tamarindo, Flamingo, and Playas del Coco.



Punta Islita and its world-class hotel is just ten minutes to the southeast, opposite from Sámara and Nosara, but on the way to Santa Teresa, Montezuma, Malpaís and Cóbano. Whatever you do, don't miss out on Islita's iconic and world-class Macaw breeding and release conservation center.
